

West Newbury Bicentennial Committee Minutes

July 2, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 6:10 pm in the First Floor Meeting Room. Committee members present Krystelle Griskiewicz, Stephen Swallow, Greg Garnache, Judith Gregg, Jocelyn Fassett, Cindy Sauter.

Angus Jennings opened the meeting by introducing the members of the West Newbury safety and emergency personnel. The Committee and Town personnel reviewed parking details in depth; the Town has volunteer personnel to assist. Parking signs have been prepared and plans for emergency and handicapped parking are in place. Garbage collection was also discussed in depth. The Fire Department is setting up temporary lighting. There will be a command tent for police, fire and emergency personnel. Dan Cena of the Police Department will be in charge of the parking detail for Field Day.

- Krystelle reported on Seacoast Events in Newburyport: They have a photo booth, a menu of giant games, lawn games. Giant games would run in the range of \$1000. The Committee also discussed procuring potato sacks, eggs etc. for races.
- Steve Swallow volunteered to monitor parking coordination in conjunction with the Police Department. KC Swallow volunteered to coordinate bus shuttles.
